Course Description: START (GR 207188) adjacent informal lay by at top of small hill on Whitwell to Codicote Road approx 1/4 mile short of junction with B656. Proceed eastwards to Codicote where turn left on to B656 to proceed northwards. At junction approx. 2.5 before Hitchin, turn left on to B651 to St. Pauls Walden and continue to Whitwell where left at T-junction and continue on the Codicote Road Pass course start point and repeat above to FINISH at course start point

Traffic Flows: Light at time of events

Course/Event History: Two laps of this course have been used by Hitchin Nomads Cycling Club (HNCC) for its annual "Spring Hilly" and "Autumn Hilly" events on Saturdays in March and October, with 09:00 start and typically less than 20 attending. This assessment is prepared specifically for HNCC events scheduled for these times and dates but can also be used (as is or adjusted as necessary) for other Clubs' events on same course (with same or different number of laps) when traffic conditions and volume of riders would be expected to be similar.
