Event HQ and Sign On

Sign on is at the Event Head Quarters (Old Warden Village Hall) from 10:00. All riders MUST sign on even if they pre-entered via the on-line survey. Entry fee is £4 for all riders, to cover CTT Event Levy, HQ Hire and disbursements. There is no charge for DNS but it is helpful (and courteous) if an Apology is passed on to the Event Crew beforehand. Junior competitors should present a completed Parental Consent Form at sign on (or bring a parent to fill one in). Entries on the day for solo riders only and before 10:30 are welcome. These will be slotted in to any DNS positions or, for slower riders and those on veteran machines, use the vacant early slots

There is plenty of parking at HQ. Please take special care when driving in or out as the HQ is adjacent to the course and competitors could be riding past at racing speed. Strictly no parking on the course. Parking near the start and finish lines for Event Crew only. Gifts of provisions (cake, biscuits, savouries, turkey sandwiches, etc.) would be most welcome. Please be prepared to help clear up the HQ after the Event!

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoter strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 **ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard-Shell Helmets**. It is recommended that a working rear light either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

All Event Crew must wear high-viz jackets, which will be provided. In the unlikely event of a severe weather warning from the Met Office or some other serious issue on the Course it may become necessary to cancel the Event or truncate the course. Every effort will be made to let riders and crew know via social media (and via email unless it is a very last-minute decision). Please check!

Course details 1U/10

This is the same course as is used for the Club's Briercliffe 10 series, with the start line moved a little closer to Southill Village where there is more space for the larger field than is typical for the course. The finish line will be moved accordingly and, for those that know it, will be where the Dave Gudgin 25 finishes - shortly after the crest of the climb through the woods out of Old Warden. There will be a chequered flag in position, which riders will see when riding out to the start from HQ. Later riders please take special care and ride singly not two abreast when heading out to the start. There may be other competitors on your route, racing to the Finish Line.

The course will be signed but there will not be turn marshals. The onus is on you to negotiate the course correctly and safely. No warming up on the Course once the Event has begun (aside from riding out from HQ to start). Continue past the Finish when you have completed the Course and do not congregate in vicinity of Time Keepers on the road. Provisional times will be shared back at HQ and not at the Finish Line.
